

WHAT HAVE WE DONE SO FAR?

Organized two great fundraisers:

- 1) Toonie Toss for Books -- Raised \$837.05
- 2) Quarter War – Raised \$4084.50

Total raised = \$4921.55



WHAT DO WE NEED HELP WITH?

- Invite the PAC to pay half of the scoreboard total which is $\$7231.70 / 2 = \3615.85
- If PAC paid for half, that would leave \$1305.70 of the money already collected from fundraising, to put towards our first sports jerseys in September with our new Grey Wolves logo



The Math: \$7231.70 (scoreboard)

- \$4921.55 (fundraised)

- \$3615.85 (PAC donation)

= **Surplus of \$1305.70**

- On May 29th Menchie's will donate 15% of their total sales for the day
- Encourage families to come to Menchie's with a photo scavenger hunt
- Families that participate and check in at Menchie's will receive an Edgewood school vinyl sticker and be entered into a draw for a gift certificate to Menchie's
