Out of 9 new teachers 7 of the teachers are within their first 2 years of teaching. SD36 SEL program (Social emotional program) coordinated by Ms Flack to focus on supporting the social and emotional wellbeing of our school. SD36 Mentoring program - led by Ms Meynert 1 day a week will work on supporting the new staff members specifically School Finances (see attached slide) Technology @ Edgewood - devices are used to support learning and to teach digital citizenship, how to be safe online, digital footprint. Textbooks are also being replaced by digital resources. PROPOSED BUDGET REVISION



- \$1,000 TOWARDS CLASSROOM OUTDOOR EQUIPMENT BINS
 - 12 NEW DIVISIONS REQUIRING FULL EQUIPMENT BINS
 - 15 DIVISIONS NEEDING VARIOUS AMOUNTS OF REPLACEMENT EQUIPMENT
- \$3,000 TOWARDS 6 COLLABORATIVE SPACES
 - \$500 PER SPACE TEACHERS WILL ADVISE ON HOW BEST TO USE THESE FUNDS
 - EXPECTED EXPENDITURES FURNITURE, GAMES, SUPPLIES
- \$3,000 FOR THE LIBRARY TO PURCHASE ADDITIONAL BOOKS
 - LESLIE BURWASH (LIBRARIAN) IS SEEING A HIGH DEMAND FOR GREAT LITERATURE
 - LIBRARY ALREADY RUNNING TWO FUNDRAISERS (FALL CHAPTERS, SPRING SCHOLASTIC)
- \$8,000 TOWARDS 20-25 IPADS AND CHARGING CART
 - WITH ~\$3,000 CONTRIBUTION FROM THE SCHOOL
 - SCHOOL CURRENTLY HAS ONE FULL CART AND WOULD LIKE TO EXPAND
 - CURRENT CART IS PRIMARILY USED IN/FOR THE LIBRARY
 - SECOND CART WOULD BE USED IN CLASSROOMS

ADJUSTED SPENDING

- \$1,800 FIELD TRIP TRANSPORTATION
 - LESS \$700 FROM PREVIOUSLY BUDGETED AMOUNT
 - NO FALL FIELD TRIPS CHANGING NUMBER TO BETTER REFLECT DEMAND FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE YEAR

EINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

- CHANGES ARE INLINE WITH PROJECTED REVENUE FOR THE YEAR
 - HOT LUNCH PROFITS EXCEEDING OUR EXPECTATIONS
 - ENGAGEMENT ACROSS OUR PARENT GROUP EXCEEDING OUR EXPECTATIONS
 - NO ADDITIONAL FUNDRAISERS REQUIRED TO SUPPORT NEW EXPENDITURES
- SURPLUS CARRY-OVER FROM LAST YEAR (~\$6,000) PROVIDES OPERATING BUFFER FOR OUR PAC MOVING FORWARD
 - LESS PRESSURE ON FUTURE EXECUTIVE TEAMS WHEN UNPLANNED SHORTFALLS MAY ARISE
