• Our hot lunch team puts in about 55 volunteer hours per month totalling about 600

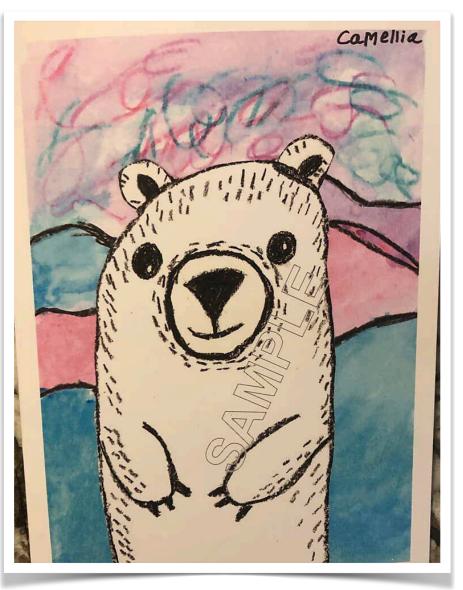
• Our volunteers are earning our school about 35\$ per hour on this program :) :)

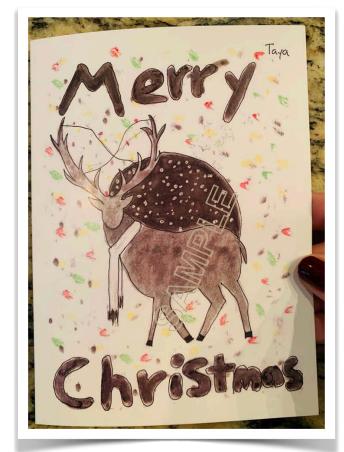






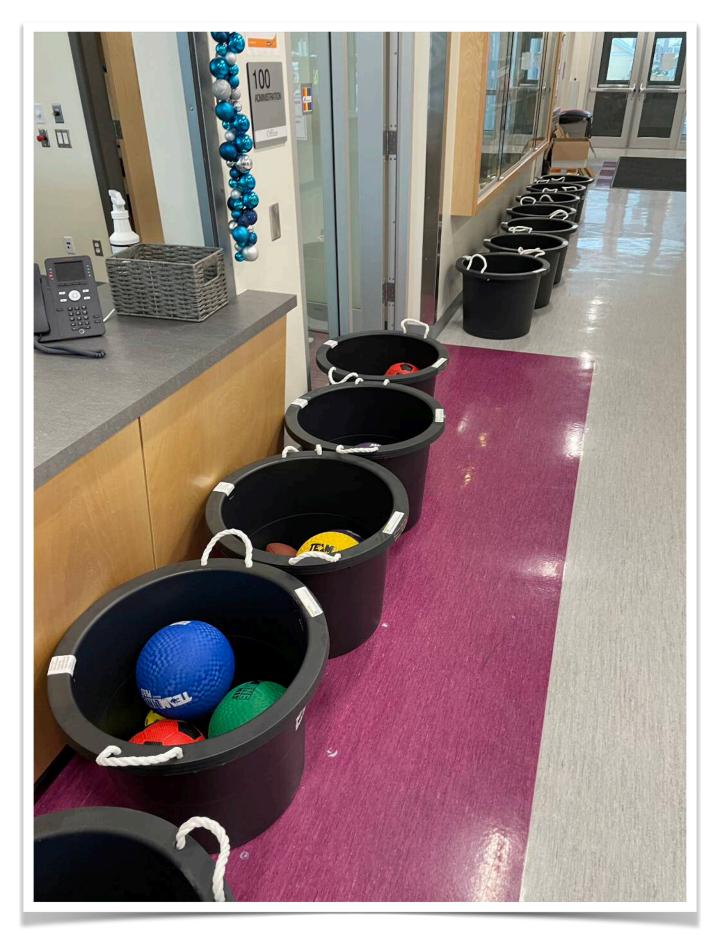






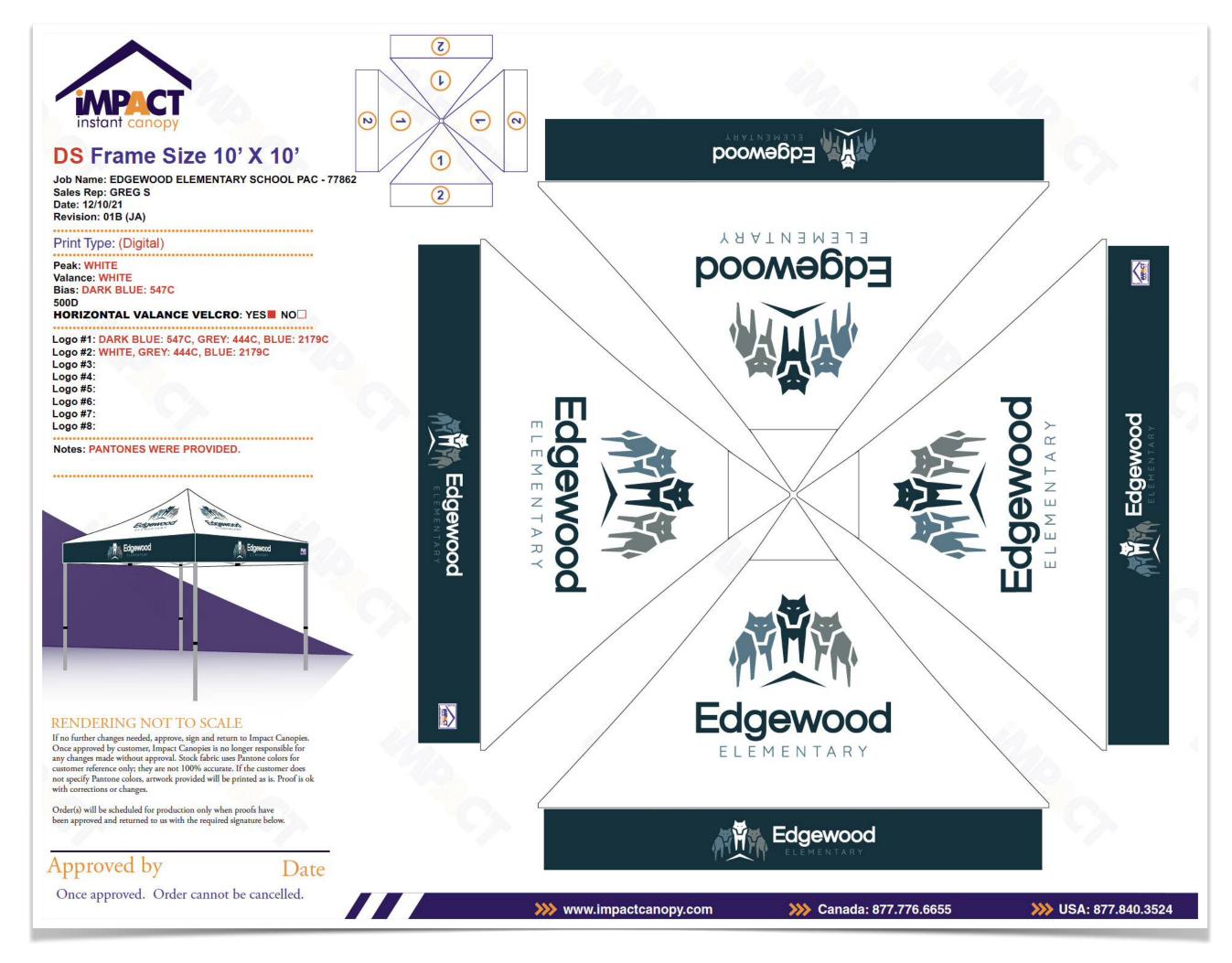
