


WHAT IS THE PARENT ADVISORY COUNCIL?

LONG TERM SAVINGS PLAN?

- EXECUTIVE PROPOSED IDEA OUTDOOR LEARNING SPACE
- PORTION OF CURRENT SURPLUS FUNDS TO BE TRANSFERRED TO THIS PROJECT
- 1-3 YEAR PLAN TO REACH A GOAL OF \$20,000 \$35,000
 - \$15,000 TRANSFER PLUS \$6500 OVER 3 YEARS = \$34,500 AVAILABLE IN SEPTEMBER OF 2025
