PRINCIPAL'S UPDATE

- Congrats to Edgewood for placing 2nd in Track. Special thanks to all the coaches
- Thank you to PAC and all volunteers for a successful first Spring Fair
- PAC has paid for the whole school to learn Hip Hop next week June 8th- 12th. Friday the 12th will be a blended intermediate/primary session. Some parents can come and watch. We have the choice to book this again for next year or maybe Zumba.
- Fun Day is on June 23rd at Edgewood Park. All are welcome to join. PAC is paying for a free hot dog for every student – claim this in Hot Lunch Portal by June 16th.
- June 25th is our last day of school with early dismissal and report cards go home
- The cost to fix the damage to our playground will be covered either by the District or the vendor (under warranty).
- Leadership committee has grown to 98 students from Grades 4-7 with a variety of responsibilities. Mostly lunch monitoring, but also Student Voice this year, tree planting and most recently they had a successful Multicultural Luncheon.
- We will sadly be losing Mr. Fairbrother next year.
- We will sadly also be losing Mrs. Burden next year as she is leaving to be a VP at another school. Our new VP will be Jennifer Samra (sp?) in September.

TREASURER'S REPORT:

- We have a surplus budget going into next year, largely due to Hot Lunch
- We amazingly managed to utilize the majority of our Gaming Funds this year, going from ~\$33,000 to ~\$3000. These funds went to support our school community. Generally, if they are not used by the end of the school year, they have to be given back, and we will get less the following year.
- Discretionary amounts given to each classroom this year was \$600. More than it has been in the past.
